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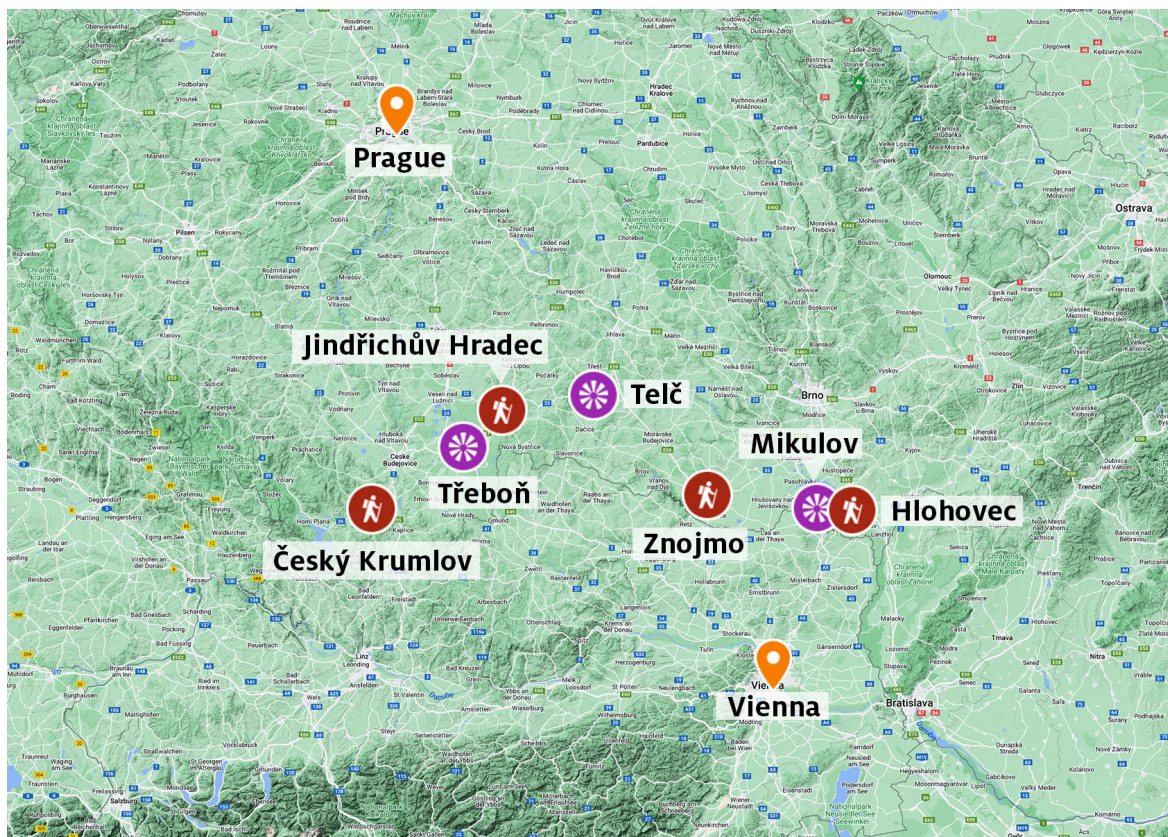


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About Your Walk

Discover the modern spirit of the new Czech Republic against the historic landscape of one of Europe's oldest countries. Crossing the border from Austria, we discover a land of rural villages rich in folklore and tradition, wooded hills, rare flowers and tranquil lakes. We marvel at Baroque architecture and meander through majestic landscaped parkland. We explore the unspoilt town of Český Krumlov and sample the beer in one of the oldest breweries in Europe. Our trip ends in the vibrant capital city of Prague, where we walk the famous Charles Bridge and visit Prague Castle, the largest ancient castle in the world.

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Walk Itinerary

Saturday

Meet for a walking tour of the old city of Vienna followed by a transfer to Lednice, former summer residence of the Liechtenstein family. Tonight, we'll enjoy a tasty Welcome Dinner.

Sunday

On our first walking day we visit a UNESCO protected area thanks to the Dukes of Liechtenstein, who transformed their extensive domains into a huge park, where the baroque and neo-gothic architecture of their chateaux are married with smaller, rural buildings in a landscape that which was fashioned according to the English principles of landscaping. In the afternoon, we visit the oldest greenhouse in Europe.

Monday

Drive westwards and walk along the river Thaya (Dyje), which forms the natural border with Austria. Its unique, untouched valley is a much beloved National Park. We will also visit a small organic winery for a wine tasting. Tonight, we stay in historic Znojmo, a picturesque town undiscovered by tourists.

Tuesday

Drive to Slavonice, a small town unchanged for centuries. After lunch, we drive on to Telc, a Renaissance jewel listed by UNESCO. We'll have a brief walk around, then finish our day at Jindrichuv Hradec (Henry's Castle) where our hotel is in the central square.

Wednesday

Walk through forests and past numerous lakes to the little town of Trebon with its colorful historic buildings, cobblestone streets and moat. After lunch in a local fish restaurant, we journey on to Český Krumlov, one of Europe's most beautiful and best-preserved towns.

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Thursday

From the hotel, walk to the richly decorated castle for a guided tour. Then drive out to enjoy our last walk through forests and along the river to Zlata Koruna, a village with a 13th century Cistercian Monastery. After lunch, free time in Český Krumlov.

Friday

Spend the whole day exploring Prague, visiting important sites in the lovely old city, including the famous astronomical clock on the medieval town hall. Farewell Dinner at a fine Prague restaurant.

There is no scheduled transfer at the end of this walk as many guests opt to stay longer in Prague.

Chateau de Frontiere

The beautiful classicist building of the Chateau de Frontière / Hraniční Zámeček is set in a beautiful floodplain woodland. In addition to the chateau, there is the four-star hotel situated opposite of the chateau, the à la carte restaurant Chateau Petit, the gastronomic Restaurant Essens and a wine cellar. Herbs, fruits, vegetables are grown in the own garden, guaranteeing freshness and top quality. The complex has a heated outdoor pool and a modern spa. The sauna world offers perfect relaxation, warming up in three saunas followed by cooling in a cooling pool, a snow room or crushed ice. You can treat yourself to a luxurious body massage in the whirlpool.

Hotel Clemar is located in the town center of Znojmo, consisting of 16th century townhouses combining history and modernity. Each room at this 4-star hotel has city views, and is supplied with air-conditioning, a desk, coffee machine, minibar, safety deposit box, a flat-screen TV and a private bathroom with walk-in shower. 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Hotel Concertino

In 1996 the Concertino ('Golden Goose') hotel opened in the historical centre of Jindrichuv Hradec, one of the most beautiful towns in South-Bohemia. Its construction cleverly incorporates buildings from the Renaissance period while producing a complex providing modern accommodation. It is located in the centre of the old town with easy access to its shopping facilities. This well-equipped hotel is surrounded by historical architecture dating back to the 13th century. Every bedroom has a hall, bathroom, hairdryer, telephone, TV, mini bar and roomsafe. The hotel's many facilities include three restaurants serving both domestic and international cuisine, lounge, cafe, bar and pub, table tennis and billiards.

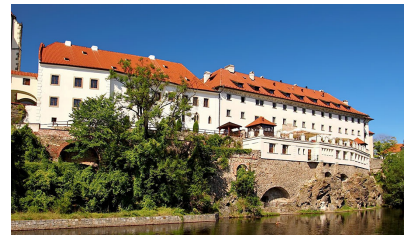

Hotel Ruze

The Hotel Ruze (the Rose) is the finest hotel in Cesky Krumlov. It was constructed in the 16th century as a Jesuit Monastery and University and has carefully preserved the beauty and style of the Renaissance, despite recent extensive interior restoration and modernisation. It is now a luxurious five star hotel, maintaining the spirit and style of the Renaissance, yet fully satisfying all the requirements of the 21st century. The restaurant and banquet hall offer Bohemian, international and medieval dishes which are served by waiters in 16th century robes. All rooms still reflect the celebrity and brilliancy of the Renaissance time and are equipped with bath, WC, satellite TV, radio, minibar, hair dryer and telephone. The hotel sports centre is equipped with pool with jet stream, gym, sauna, solarium, massage, hairdressing and beauty salon.

Hotel Paris

Hotel Paris Prague is a family-run hotel located in the historical centre of Prague. This Art Nouveau style hotel was founded in 1904 by the Brandejs hotelier family. The Hotel Paris Prague was built by the renowned architect Jan Vejrych. The interior of the hotel was designed by the architect Antonín Pfeiffer, and the ceramic mosaics are from the workshop of Jan Köhler. The Hotel Paris Prague has retained its unmistakable appearance of a pretentious neo-gothic building for more than one hundred years. It offers French and traditional Czech cuisines in the Sarah Bernhardt Restaurant, a relaxing atmosphere in The Café de Paris coffee house, as well as a Wellness & Spa Centre with Thai massages. Featuring free Wi-Fi, the airy, sophisticated rooms come with flat-screen TVs and minibars. The reception desk is open 24 hours, room service, and laundry and iron service are available.
